



## Strategic pillar: Improving quality of laboratory



#### 2020 Targets

- Enroll 2,500 labs in the WHO SLIPTA quality improvement program
- Enable 250 labs to achieve accreditation





## **Advancing SLIPTA Program: How does it looks like?**

#### **Institutionalization of SLIPTA**

- Identify national &regional institutions for SLIPTA collaboration
- Train and certify a pool of auditors within these institutions
- Accredit these institutions to be ASLM centers for SLIPTA

# Overaching and coordination role of ASLM

- Approve these centers' request to conduct SLIPTA audits
- Issue SLIPTA certificates
- Conduct quality checks and maintain database of audited labs

Harnessing partner's resources for SLIPTA funding

• Identify partners programs that require laboratory audits and link them to official ASLM SLIPTA audits

## **Advancing SLIPTA program**

- Develop in-country capacity and be able to reach all the laboratories and countries in Africa
- A country owned program that is housed and driven by ministry of health departments utilizing the resources available
- SLIPTA becomes a national Quality Assurance program
- Building strong collaborations with various stakeholders, donor agencies and implementing partners
- Use the local auditors and reduce the cost of the SLIPTA

#### **ASLM 2018 – 2023 Vision**

Goal 3 - Quality of Laboratory Services: Improve the quality of laboratory services towards accreditation based on national, regional and international standards.

#### **Strategic Objectives**

- 3.1. Empower the expansion of SLIPTA to all regions of the continent by promoting country ownership; by linking SLIPTA to national and regional regulatory frameworks; and by synergizing laboratory capacity building activities of regional organizations (such as WAHO and ECSA) working with AU member states.
- 3.2. In collaboration with Africa CDC, WHO-AFRO and WHO-EMRO facilitate awareness of Quality Management Systems (QMS) through advocacy in all AU Member States
- 3.4 Enhance the SLIPTA coordination and training mechanism of ASLM through the use of new technologies (e.g. E-tools and digitalized data collection platforms) and strategic partnerships.
- 3.5 Optimize the cost-effectiveness of QMS implementation by reinforcing linkages between SLIPTA, mentoring programs & tools (such as Strengthening Laboratory Management Toward Accreditation-SLMTA), and by improving the Monitoring & Evaluation of QMS implementation and impact on health outcomes.
